OBD OBJA SYMPOSIUM 45: *Slovene in the Era of Smart Technology*

GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS

The guidelines are written here, an example of the formatted text is on page 3.

1. The text must be submitted no later than **5 May 2026** on the website <https://centerslo.si/simpozij-obdobja/>. It is the responsibility of the authors to ensure the linguistic suitability of their contributions.
Contributions which **do not adhere to the guidelines** with regard to length, layout and formatting, citations and other technical guidelines will be **rejected**. In such instances, authors can amend their contribution in line with the guidelines and **resubmit it**.
2. **The text of the paper** can extend to a **maximum of 20,000 characters with spaces** (all the characters in the document, including the abstract, notes and literature).
3. At the beginning of the text, the following **information** should be provided, which will appear in the symposium monograph:
 - Name and surname of the author(s),
 - Name and the address/place of the institution where the author(s) is/are employed – please write the institution name in full,
 - E-mail of the author(s).
4. The paper should include an **abstract** (roughly five lines) in Slovene and English and **five key words**, also in Slovene and English.
5. The text should be written in **Times New Roman**, font size **11**, with **line spacing of 1.5**. The abstract, summary and keywords should be in font size **10**, as should footnotes, captions to figures, tables, etc.
6. **Longer citations** (five lines or more) should be separated from the surrounding text, beginning on a new line and written in font size **10**.
7. **Omission in a citation** should be indicated by three dots in square brackets: [...].
8. **Chapters** should be numbered and headed. Numbering begins with 1: for example, 1 Introduction, 2 Hypotheses, 2.1 and so on.
9. **Sources of citations** should be included in the main text in brackets – for example (Stritar Kučuk 2022: 109), for works with two authors, surnames are separated by *and* (Ferbežar and Krajnc 2025: 106). For works with three or more authors, only the surname of the first author is given, followed by *et al.* (Eniko et al. 2022) – and clarified in the bibliography at the end of the paper.
10. **Notes** should be footnotes (i.e. at the foot of the page where the relevant piece of text appears).
11. **Images, tables, graphs**, etc. should be numbered and captioned – e.g. Picture 3: Congress Square in 1919 (source: personal archive). A period should follow the title of the image, table, graph, etc. If the visual material is subject to copyright, the author must obtain copyright clearance.

When selecting visual material, please bear in mind that the proceedings will be **printed in black and white**. Visual material should be submitted as separate files (e.g. in TIFF or JPG format) with a resolution of at least 300 dpi.

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12. The **titles** of publications, such as books, conference proceedings, and periodicals should be in *italics*.
13. **Acknowledgments, mentions of projects**, etc., should be placed after the main text and before the bibliography.
14. In the **bibliography** at the end of the paper, include only publications cited in the text.
The bibliography should be arranged in **alphabetical order**.
The names of authors, journals, publishers, etc. should be given **in full**.
If possible, provide **permanent identifiers** (DOI, handle, etc.) for the publications.

References should follow the 7th edition of the [APA style manual](#).
